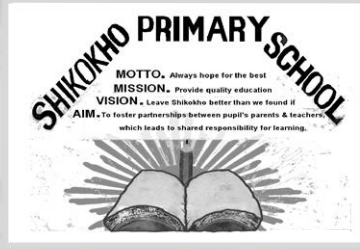
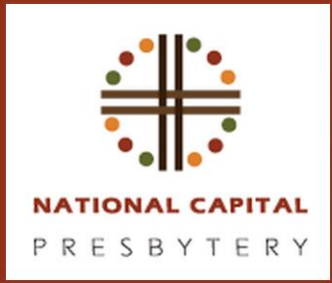

**Brief sentence for listing:**

Design, establish and maintain US institutional partnerships with selected locations around the world, for exchanges and mutually themed projects and programs. Appropriate technology and self-help concepts are particularly considered and emphasized for sustainability.

**Paragraph for Overseas Educational and Medical Mission Management:**

Design and direct two-week / two-month / two-year field visits to intuitional partnership locations around the world – grass roots to grass tops. From Memorandum of Understanding, organizing orientation and materials as well as post-travel wrap up and debriefing. Survey and synthesize partnership and team members' interests and needs, coordinate daily activities as necessary. Project partnership themes may include: teaching at day care / primary / secondary / university levels / library science / scholarship programs, fellowships at medical clinics, water initiatives, microfinance initiatives, electrification, HIV/AIDS, orphan feeding and day care, heifer project, tree nursery, village security, IT initiatives, operational procedures for local partner members. This model of partnership is based on a thirty+ year tri-lateral collaboration and is heralded as a national model as the first rural clinic in Kenya which is sponsored by three groups: the Kenyan government, local women's group, and U.S. church.
